Targeted for singers 55+ the chorale includes folks who want to return to singing, have sung their entire lives, or would love to begin the adventure of singing. Do you fall into any of these categories?

The nonprofit **Encore Creativity for Older Adults** chorale program is the largest in the country for people over 55. Originating in Washington DC, Encore ensembles have now spread across the US. With seven chorales, Chicago is now the largest Encore affiliate. Encore shares research which has found that singing in a choral organization provides the opportunity for older persons to stay mentally and social engaged. While a recent 3-year study of 150 singers over 55 found that "participants in professionally led choral programs take fewer medications, experience less depression and make fewer visits to doctors."
